Blaenavon Heritage Railway, located on the edge of the Brecon Beacons, is the highest standard gauge railway in the UK and is situated within the Blaenavon World Heritage site.

Every running day the railway requires footplate crews, guards, ticket inspectors, ticket office, tearoom and buffet carriage staff, duty managers, stationmasters and track workers. Volunteers can be trained and mentored by a member of our experienced team.

There are also opportunities in general maintenance, restoration of track and rolling stock, stations, landscaping and customer care.to ensure the smooth running of the railway.

As a volunteer you can expect training in your chosen area of work, for example:

Volunteers must be members of either the railway company or society and benefits of membership include 50% discount on travel on the railway (when not on duty), free tea, coffee or bottled water whilst on duty and also 5% discount on purchases in both our shops and 10% discount on purchases from our tearoom.

Young people (minimum age 14) are welcome to apply to be a volunteer and will be supervised at all times by an experienced member of staff.
